When I found VOICES FOR PETS it was like a beam of light shinning through an otherwise dark and desperate time.

Simply put VOICES FOR PETS literally saved the life of my sweet kitty Gata. Gata, who is 14 years old, became deathly ill on a Sunday night. I called over 20 places. No one called me back except for Leroy at VOICES FOR PETS.

I am a person with three major disabilities, one of which being a form of quadraplegia and another being Severe Depression and Anxiety.

Leroy listened patiently and responded in under an hour. He did go beyond the call of duty and I cannot find the words to express the ultimate gratitude I have and will always have to VOICES FOR PETS.

I, personally, do not mind how what I am about to say sounds because it is the truth. Gata is like my fuzzy child and best friend. When I'm sad or scared she sits right next to me and kneads my side. And when my body pain increases in any way, she knows, and will come and lay on my lower back, which is where 95% of the pain stems from.

Another major disability I have is a form of epilepsy, which leads to severe panic attacks as well as mild to severe seizures. Gata also assists/helps me deal with this disability every day and every long scary night.

My nights and my frightening panic attacks (which can and at times do lead into a degree of a seizure) have lessened measurably since my kitty Gata became well due to the efforts of VOICES FOR PETS. Gata and I have somewhat of a symbiotic relationship. When I'm sad, she comes right to me. When she plays and acts like a kitten, my clinical depression is lessened and I laugh which is the best medicine. Laughter and love — I can almost see it surround my Gata now.

She was so very sick and I almost lost her. Now at this very second, Gata is chasing a catnip toy and a straw up and down the hall as if she were a kitten again. She is happy again and showing it all the time and this of course helps me instantaneously to come out of a deep, deep, depression and/or a controllable seizure.

I have not seen Gata play and eat this much in such a long time that I thought she was too old to act this way again. NOT SO. Not so indeed! Ever since the infection has cleared Gata's system she has been playing and acting like a kitten.

I have my little girl back and she sure let's me know this when she's running up and down the hall at 1 AM. ☺ I cannot believe it! And now I have to save up for cat toys because there is now a brand new need for them!!!

My Gata is playing every day and every night! She is full of life again!

Thank you VOICES FOR PETS for saving my little girl and giving her and I more time together — joyous time.
